The programmes in Medical Biology provide students with a comprehensive knowledge of human biology from a medical perspective; both in terms of the causes of disease, and the methods and technologies used to treat and diagnose disease.

+ Course highlights

You will be taught by highly qualified lecturers with expertise and research experience in areas such as molecular biology, systems and synthetic biology, genomics and infectious diseases, biomaterials, biomodelling, protein biochemistry and genetics.

The programmes are delivered in the £4 million Queens Specialist Building which hosts modern new teaching facilities and laboratories. This represents a significant investment in the Medical Biology programme, aimed at the successful delivery of the programme and professional development of our students.

The course is designed to help prepare those students wishing to apply for graduate-entry medicine programmes for their entrance examinations.

The MSc Sport Rehabilitation is accredited by the British Association of Sport Rehabilitators and Trainers (BASRaT) which allows employment internationally.

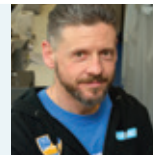

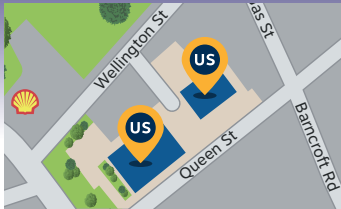
